Programming

There are two methods available to program the weemote® dV when using it with a DVD player. These methods are a built-in DVD code library covering most major brand DVD players or the use of a learning feature. The learning feature not only allows you to setup DVD players that may not be in our code library but also allows you to selectively chose which controls you wish to enable.

The learning feature is used exclusively when setting up the weemote® dV to work with a device other than a DVD player, i.e. DVR, VCR, Set-Top Device, etc.

An extensive library of DVD codes are available - just look up your brand DVD player and enter that code. If you can't find a proper code or wish to only activate some of the buttons on the weemote® dV, you can use the learning feature.

The learning feature allows you to take your existing remote control and have the weemote® dV "learn" the button controls you want to use.

All program settings and controls are normally hidden and secured from the child.



Removing the battery door screw on the back cover allows you to remove the weemote® dV front cover which reveals the program buttons A, B, and C

1. How does the weemote® dV differ from the weemote® TV remote?

The weemote® dV is specifically designed to allow children to access and control content interactively when using onscreen menus such as those typically found on DVD media. The weemote® 3 TV remote is designed to allow control of live TV content, i.e. television or Set-Top channel/s selected by the parent.

For example in the case of a DVR device such as a TiVo® player, the weemote® dV allows access to recorded content in the Now Playing list while the weemote® 3 TV remote allows access to specific channels you set while accessing the Live TV mode of the TiVo® player.

2. Why should I consider a separate remote for my child?

With the significant increase of interactive content available on digital video devices and interactive television today, children often become frustrated because they cannot easily access the interactive content because of the complexity of traditional remote controls. Often they require a vast amount of parental assistance. The compact size and large navigational buttons of the weemote® dV enable children to simply navigate through interactive contents and have fun while learning.

5. After I program the weemote® dV, how safe are the settings?

The weemote® dV is housed in durable casing that offers a secured battery and program door so parents do not have to worry about children changing the codes or removing the batteries. All settings are also permanently stored in memory regardless of the state of your batteries.

6. How involved is it to setup the weemote® dV?

Set-up is easy. The weemote® dV offers two types of setup. It comes with a complete library of Setup Codes for virtually any DVD Player. Parents simply find the compatible code for their brand of DVD player and enter it into the remote

and the device is ready to use. For those DVD players that are not supported or for the setup of the weemote dV with different devices such as a DVR (TiVo®) or Set-Top device, the weemote dV offers a “full learning technology” feature. The full learning technology feature enables parents to point and click their existing remote at the weemote dV and it will automatically learn the commands and controls of the existing remote and reliably replicate them.

Some excellent interactive DVD content titles to consider are Disney's Lilo and Stitch's [Islands of Adventure Board Game](#) and the [Adventureville](#) series of interactive shows. These titles alone can provide hours of enriching entertainment when children are empowered to control them using the weemote® dV.
